

Coordinators and Organizers Should Know:

The Healthy Youth Survey (HYS) provides critical data to support schools, communities, and policymakers in understanding and addressing the needs of youth. As a coordinator or organizer, your role is essential in helping schools, families, and students feel confident and informed about their participation.

What to Share with Schools, Families, and Youth:

Completely Confidential: The survey responses are not connected to individual students through identifiers.

Voluntary Participation: Students can skip any question or opt out of participation altogether.

Student Voice Matters: The HYS provides youth with an opportunity to share their experiences confidentially, which helps shape and improve programs and services.

Small & Rural School Options:

- Districts with fewer than 150 students in grades 6, 8, 10, and 12 can also survey grades 7, 9, and 11.
- Grades 6 and 7 receive a shorter, simpler version of the survey.
- This flexibility enables small schools to collect more accurate, locally relevant data.

Survey Customization:

Schools can request exemptions or opt in to a few of the questions to better fit their communities.

Timeline and Key Tasks:

Spring

- HYS registration opens.
- Identify the HYS coordinator for your district.
- Utilize flyers from the HYS Planning Committee to promote participation.
- Check your district's registration status at AskHYS.net.
- Review FAQs and survey content: askhys.net/About#FAQ.

End of June

- Check in with your district's HYS Coordinator.
- Start planning for fall implementation with Student Assistance Professionals (SAPs) and school staff.

Fall

- Attend back-to-school events to share HYSPC-approved fact sheets and information and information about HYS with youth and families.
- Share the Healthy Youth Survey Intro Video with schools, families, and youth youtube.com/watch?v=XcyEQznDqwQ
- Assist with survey administration in October.

Following Spring

- Survey results released.
- Access county data on AskHYS.net. District-level data requires login.
- With required permissions share data with schools, families, and students to guide programs and policies. Utilize various HYS data presentations: askhys. net/Resources/Data
